Piloting report PR4 – PCG

1. Introduction

The Bonding project has created an online platform to facilitate intergenerational networking. It was designed to enable young volunteers and volunteer organizations to share knowledge, experiences, best practices and achievements in building relationships with seniors.

PCG invited 25 participants via electronic mail. The survey had a stationary character. In the end, 16 participants took part in the study - 5 men and 11 women. The survey was designed to examine the functionality, content and usability of the platform.

2. Methodology

PCG organized a desktop study according to the following scenario. At the post office, the platform was presented, especially its functionalities: a forum with thematic areas, a blog, an individual area that each user can customize, a wide range of possibilities for creating groups, and educational tools that will help people interested in the topic of the project to establish intergenerational relations.

The content was clear and understandable. The presentation was carried out in such a way as not to overwhelm the respondents. Respondents themselves were also able to ask questions and express their observations about both the platform itself and the topic discussed. After the session, we asked the participants to fill out an anonymous evaluation questionnaire.

3. Results

All individuals completed the questionnaire. The distribution of results is as follows:

Suggestions:

- Including seniors in the platform's activities would have a positive impact on developing intergenerational dialogue and help familiarize them with new technologies, which is a step towards blurring IT-technology barriers.
- Allowing users to publish blog posts after prior moderation would add value to the platform by encouraging active participation and content sharing.
- Expanding the community of users in the future would add to the dynamism and richness of the experiences exchanged on the platform.
- Expanding the platform's functionality to include tools that support interactive workshops and webinars could significantly enrich the educational offering, encouraging users to engage and learn even more deeply through direct participation.

4. Conclusions

The survey confirmed the platform's popularity among young people, offering a dynamic environment for sharing knowledge, information, networking and having conversations about building intergenerational friendships. The platform has successfully attracted young people, earning them recognition as a place to enable valuable exchange and communication.
