Befriending services – What are they?

- Befriending services are part of the social landscape in several countries inside and outside Europe, provided by individuals from various backgrounds to a range of groups such as children, parents and elderly.
- They are increasingly perceived as central to healthy ageing strategies, through the prevention of social isolation and loneliness.
- However, they remain rather unknown in several countries that are missing out on this valuable potential resource.



Having and showing respect for and to one another builds trust, collaboration and well-being.

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




# 4. Good listening skills


## 7. Kindness


